GREETING OF THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR PROF. GEORGE XENAKIS

[ΕΛ] Τα διεθνή δρώμενα International AV Choral Events αποτελούν μέρος ενός σημαντικού θεσμού στον χώρο της χορωδιακής μουσικής που έχει αναπτυχθεί τα τελευταία 35 έτη στην ευρύτερη περιοχή των Βαλκανίων. Ξεκινώντας το 1988 στο Καρπενήσι ως Διεθνές Χορωδιακό Φεστιβάλ Καρπενησίου, τα δρώμενα International AV Choral Events πλέον συνδιοργανώνονται σε συνεργασία με δημόσιους και ιδιωτικούς φορείς στην Ελλάδα (Καρπενήσι), στη Βουλγαρία (Γκάμπροβο) και στη Ρουμανία (Πιτέστι). Η θερμή αποδοχή του θεσμού μας από τους τοπικούς φορείς, την τοπική κοινωνία και ενός μεγάλου συνόλου καλλιτεχνών και χορωδιακών συνόλων διεθνώς, οι οποίοι επισκέπτονται πολλές φορές το φεστιβάλ μας, είναι η καρδιά του θεσμού αυτού που μας γεμίζει δύναμη για την συνέχιση των προσπάθειών μας παρά τις καθημερινές δυσκολίες

που αντιμετωπίζει ο τόπος μας και η χώρα μας γενικότερα. Εφέτος είμαστε ιδιαίτερα ικανοποιημένοι για την συνέχιση του ιστορικού μας θεσμού, μετά από τις μεγάλες παγκόσμιες δοκιμασίες καθώς και την δυσχέρεια διεξαγωγής προβών από τους χορωδούς. Ευχαριστούμε θερμά την Περιφέρεια Στερεάς Ελλάδας, τον Δήμο Καρπενησίου, Ευρυτανίας και την εταιρία *Fogus Innovations and Services P.C.* για την ευγενική τους υποστήριξη με διαφορετικούς τρόπους και μέσα.

[ΕΝ] The International AV Choral Events are part of an important long-lived tradition in the field of choral music that has been developed over the past 35 years in the wider Balkan region. Beginning in 1988 in Karpenisi as a Festival, the International AV Choral Events are now being co-organized with public and private organizations in Greece (Karpenissi), Bulgaria (Gabrovo) and Romania (Pitesti). The warm acceptance of our activities by the local community and a large group of artists and choral ensembles all around the world, who choose to visit our festival not only once but many times, is the heart of our cultural events that fills us with hope to continue our efforts despite the daily difficulties that our beautiful hometown and country faces. This year we warmly welcome all choir members and friends that have managed to put together their voices, despite the worldwide difficulties that we have all faced (including the lack of rehearsals) worldwide. We also cordially thank the Prefecture of Central Greece, the Municipality of Karpenisi as well as Fogus Innovations and Services P.C. for the different roles and means that they have chosen to support our actions.

[ΕΝ] With the kind support of the local community, authorities, and choirs participating in our events, the International AV Choral Events GREECE are currently a reference point for the choral activities in the Greek Region, the EU and the entire world, given the notable participation of International choirs in our events. Prof. George Xenakis
ΕΛΛΑΔΑ / GREECE

Prof. George Xenakis is specialized in phonetics, choral art and choir conduction. He has studied Advanced Theoretics and Byzantine Music at the National Conservatory of Athens and received his counter point and Fuga diploma at the Synchronous Conservatory of Athens. Since 1982, he has been a Music Professor in Karpenisi and with his initiative the Mixed Choir of Karpenisi was founded in 1986. At his noteworthy course in choir art, he has put on various plays for choir and orchestra of Classical and contemporary composers, while he has also conducted numerous symphonic orchestras from Greece and Bulgaria. In 1992 he put on the Holy Liturgy of Ioannis Hrisostomos composed by Mikis Theodorakis, at the Holy Temple of Evrytanian Saints in Karpenissi. Professor Xenakis has given more than 200 concerts in Greece and abroad, and since 1988 he is the artistic director of the International AV Choral Events.



Todor Kabakchiev
ΒΟΥΛΓΑΡΙΑ / BULGARIA

Todor was born in Svistov, and studied at the Musical Pedagogical University of Plovdiv. He received a diploma from the State Conservatory of Sofia and taught at the Musical University of Plovdiv. For many years he has directed the oldest choir of Bulgaria "Janko Mustakov". He won many gold awards by participating in annual Bulgarian cultural festivals and recorded concerts broadcasted by Radi Sofia, Essen and BBC. For his entire artistic presence in Bulgaria and in Europe in 2002, the Ministry of Culture of Bulgaria called him "Honorable Citizen" and awarded him the "Golden Key" of his hometown. In the long course of his artistic career in Greece he has collaborated with many great Greek composers, such as Theodorakis, Kougioumtzis, Tokas, Andreopoulos, Leontis etc. He has performed with great Greek singers like Farantouri, Basis, Kouloumbis, etc. In May 2006, he won the first prize in the UNESCO competition. He is the inspirer and artistic director of the Nafpaktos Choir Festival "Mikis Theodorakis".

Bat-Kol Girls Choir, Tel Aviv Israel

Bat-Kol Girls' Choir of the Israel Conservatory of Music, Tel Aviv, conducted by Anat Morahg, was founded in 1984. Bat-Kol has won first prizes and gold medals in international competitions and festivals in Finland, Austria, Italy, England, the Netherlands, Spain, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Germany, Switzerland and China (by the invitation

of the Chinese Ministry of Culture). In April 2019 Bat-Kol went on a concert tour in London and Manchester (UK) by the invitation of the local Jewish communities. In April 2011 the representative Bat-Kol Girls' Choir participated in the Slovakia Cantat 2011 International Choir Competition, in which Bat-Kol won three gold medals as well as the Grand Prix achieving the highest score among the 27 competing choirs of various types: women's choirs, men and mixed choirs. In addition, Anat Morahg was awarded the competition's Special Prize for Excellent Conducting Performance. Bat-Kol Girls' Choir frequently performs with the Israeli Opera ("Pique Dame", "La Bohem", "Turandot", "Carmen", "Pagliachi", "Boris Gudonov", "Tosca"). Bat-Kol performed with the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra under Maestro Zubin Mehta, and many other orchestras, and in concerts for the general public. The choir's repertoire includes classical music, Israeli music, including works written especially for Bat-Kol, as well as folk songs and popular music. The members of the choir receive a wide range of musical education: solfeggio, voice training, posture, movement and acting. Two fully-staged operas were recently produced by Bat-Kol were and were performed by the choir to thousands of children and families in the Tel-Aviv area. They won rave reviews and were broadcasted by the "Kol Hamusica" radio station. Currently Bat-Kol Choir consists of about 150 children where next to the representative choir ages 12 to 18, there are two younger choirs, ages 6 to 8 and 8 to 12. The pianist accompanying the choir is Efrat Levi.

The "Lashir Byachad" choir is from the city of Modiin, Israel. The choir represents the Yachad community - a unique and innovative community that includes a school and educational facilities which combine students from a wide array of religious and secular families, intended to apply values of tolerance to diverse lifestyles. The choir is comprised of male and female adult singers, most of whom are parents to children studying in the Yachad schools. The choir was founded in

2004. During the past 13 years it is working under the musical direction and conduction of Mr. Itay Lev. The choir repertoire includes classical and popular Israeli songs from all times with original rock and Pop arrangements. The choir performs in many of the cultural events of the Yachad community and participates in music festivals, choir assemblies and diverse cultural events in Israel. The choir released a disc which includes a repertoire of its best songs.
